- The Infrastructure Committee will continue to work to obtain support from the City of Indianapolis to repair our crumbling roads and sidewalks.
- The Security Committee is continuing to work with Geist Patrol to prevent speeding and rolling through stop signs on two major roads, Old Stone Drive and Courageous Drive.

Questions from your neighbors...

Why does the Carroll Road Trail not completely connect to the Admirals? GHPOA has previously investigated this issue & has learned that the area between the trail's end & Bay Forrest Dr. is a Marion County Right of Way where all utilities are located. This changes what was once believed to be an easy & affordable project into a more complicated one, most likely requiring costly engineering drawings, and the utility issues might preclude the City of Indianapolis from granting a permit. As a result, the project has been put on hold.
